

GENERAL NOTES

1. MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 104.04 OF THE INDIANA STATE HIGHWAY STANDARD SPECIFICATION, DATE 1988, THE

2. CONTRACTOR SHALL BE REQUIRED TO ERECT AND MAINTAIN ALL CONSTRUCTION

MAINTAINING TRAFFIC DURING CONSTRUCTION, IT SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE

4. MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC AS SHOWN IN THE DETAIL SHALL BE REQUIRED ONLY







TYPICAL WORK SECTION

NOTE: 1. ONE SIDE (PREFERABLY THE LEFT SIDE) MUST BE CLEAR AND ACCESSIBLE FOR TRUCK-CRANE OPERATIONS.

2. SHEETING IS REQUIRED WHERE SOIL CONDITIONS WILL NOT ALLOW A SAFE WORKABLE PIT. ANY PORTION OF PIT NOT SHEETED MUST BE SLOPED FOR SAFETY OF MEN AND EQUIPMENT. PIT CONSTRUCTION TO COMPLY WITH ALL PROVISIONS, REQUIREMENTS AND LATESTED REVISIONS OF THE FEDERAL OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH ACT OF 1970.




